



Over 365m Christians in 120 countries face persecution and discrimination and the figure goes on climbing year on year. In many countries the persecution is extreme and thousands are now dying for their faith in Christ.

This is the biggest crisis facing the Church today; Jesus warned that it would happen but many churches in the West do not realise the extent of what is happening and are therefore not best placed to support the victims in the way that the apostles intended.

There is a great deal that individuals and congregations can do to help their brothers and sisters and the benefits are not all one-way since the victims of persecution have much to teach us including how to "be prepared" - the conclusion of Jesus' four parables about the end times.
