Ecumenical Pilgrimage to Landévennec 2020

Paying the Costs

The Companions of Saint Guénolé working group comes under the auspices of Churches Together in Cornwall and is a group of volunteers who strive to keep the costs of pilgrimage to Landévennec to a minimum. The Group is not a commercial travel company so does not announce a single charge for the pilgrimage because there are many unknowns: ferry prices, the cost of booking coaches for travel in Britain and in France, cost of accommodation and meals at the monastery. In addition, there is uncertainty caused by changing exchange rates. Based on past experience, however, we estimate the total cost for the 2020 pilgrimage is likely to be between £350 and £390 per person.

We will ask pilgrims on the 2020 journey for the following:

- A deposit of £20 with your completed application form as an expression of commitment. The deposit will be refundable if you decide to cancel before 31 January 2020.
- 2. When you receive an acknowledgement that your application and deposit have been accepted, you personally should make a reservation as a foot passenger with Brittany Ferries, on-line or by phone, for the following sailings:

Plymouth to Roscoff - 22.00 on Wednesday 29 April 2020 Roscoff to Plymouth – 15.00 on Monday 4 May 2020

The amount you pay will depend on your choice of on-board accommodation. Fares quoted in September 2019 for off-peak travel were as follows: the basic fare is £30 per person each way between Plymouth and Roscoff (£60 return). For the overnight crossing, a 2 berth cabin costs a further £55 (i.e. £27.50 each) and a 4 berth/large 2 berth cabin costs £75 (i.e. £37.50 each for two). There is a less expensive alternative of reserving a reclining seat in a lounge at a cost of £5.

- 3. Please be aware that there is a steeply stepped gangway up to the ship in Plymouth where you are required to carry your own luggage. If you will need assistance to board, make sure you request this with Brittany Ferries at the time of booking.
- 4. When we know the remaining costs, you will be asked to pay a balance to cover coaches for travel in Britain and in France and the cost of accommodation and meals at the monastery. Cheques should be made payable to: Companions of Saint Guénolé.
